Origins of the Christian Kabbalah

Magic was not a major fea-ture of the medieval Judaic Kabbalah, but it was not neglected either⁹ Later Developments The modern Judaic Kabbalah

owes a great deal to the work of a community of 16th-century Jewish scholars who settled in Safed (Tzafed), Galilee, traditional burial site of the second-century rabbi Shimon bar Yochai, mentioned in the Zohar¹⁰ Preeminent among the Safed scholars
